- **Keaton S** almost never strikes out (5% K rate over 115 PA) — pitch to soft contact, not around her.
- **Layken H** walks 23% of the time (52 PA) — very patient, attack the zone early rather than nibbling.
- **Aryanna G** have not hit much this season (high strikeout rate, low average) — challenge them in the zone, don't waste good pitches being careful.
- **Hannah A** is an extreme ground-ball hitter (81% of balls in play) — tighten the infield when she's up.

- **Base stealing is a major weapon:** 194 attempts across 48 games (4/game) at a 95% success rate. Prioritize quick catcher pop times and varied pitcher hold times.
- **Bunts more than average** (28 sac bunts in 48 games) – stay ready for small ball.

Ordered by a blended on-base/power/strikeout score ($OBP \times 0.5 + SLG \times 0.3 - K\% \times 0.2$), with the single highest-slugging bat pulled into the cleanup (4th) slot. Players below the plate-appearance threshold, and any names listed in `exclude_batters`, are left off.

Against this opponent, control matters more than usual. Carolina Cardinals Jonas 12u National steals at a 95% success rate — every walk and wild pitch is a near-certain stolen base. Lucy Calla's walk rate (14%) and wild-pitch rate (7%) make her the safer choice here.

Auto-Generated Strategy Notes

1. **Penelope V** is wilder (29% walk rate) — work the count, take borderline pitches.
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3. **Layken H** walks 23% of the time (52 PA) — very patient, attack the zone early rather than nibbling.
4. **Aryanna G** have not hit much this season (high strikeout rate, low average) — challenge them in the zone, don't waste good pitches being careful.
